## Psalm 51:1 paraphrase

Have mercy on me, O God, because of Your sacrificial love that far exceeds the limits of ordinary human love and because of Your tenderness completely wipe away and remove from the book my revolt and stepping over Your line.

God's love doesn't depend on His mood or duty – it's guided by His compassion

## Psalm 51:2-4

Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin. For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. Against You, You only, have I sinned and done what is evil in Your sight; so You are right in Your verdict and justified when You judge.

## 6 ( CLEANSE ME LITERALLY MEANS \_\_\_\_\_ )

### Isaiah 43:25

I, even I, am He who blots out your transgressions, for My own sake, and remembers your sins no more.

### Psalm 51:10-12

Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from Your presence or take Your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of Your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.

### Psalm 51:13-15

Then I will teach transgressors Your ways, so that sinners will turn back to You. Deliver me from the guilt of bloodshed, O God, You who are God my Savior, and my tongue will sing of Your righteousness. Open my lips, Lord, and my mouth will declare Your praise. You do not delight in sacrifice, or I would bring it; You do not take pleasure in burnt offerings. My sacrifice, O God, is a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart You, God, will not despise.

### Psalm 51:18-19

### 2 Samuel 12:24-25

Then David comforted his wife Bathsheba, and he went to her and made love to her. She gave birth to a son, and they named him Solomon. The Lord loved him; and because the Lord loved him, He sent word through Nathan the prophet to name him Jedidiah.
