HAVING THE RIGHT FRIENDS LUKE 5:17-26

Hebrews 11:1 NIV Now faith is the confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

FAITH IS BELIEVING TO BE TRUE WHAT YOU HAVE NO PHYSICAL PROOF OF BUT GOD GUARANTEES BY HIMSELF.

Mark 1:40-45 NIV

A man with leprosy came to him and begged him on his knees, "If you are willing, you can make me clean." Jesus was indignant. He reached out His hand and touched the man. "I am willing," he said. "Be clean!" Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cleansed. Jesus sent him away at once with a strong warning: "See that you don't tell this to anyone. But go, show yourself to the priest and offer the sacrifices that Moses commanded for your cleansing, as a testimony to them." Instead he went out and began to talk freely, spreading the news. As a result, Jesus could no longer enter a town openly but stayed outside in lonely places. Yet the people still came to Him from everywhere.

As a result of the leper's healing and testimony, Jesus became an even bigger celebrity and "people still came to Him from everywhere." **Mark 1:45**

Luke 5:17 NIV

One day Jesus was teaching, and Pharisees and teachers of the law were sitting there. They had come from every village of Galilee and from Judea and Jerusalem. And the power of the Lord was with Jesus to heal the sick.

Mark 2:2 NIV

So many gathered that there was no room left, not even outside the door, and He preached the word to them.

At the time of this story, Judaism had become a book religion – there was a whole bunch of rules to follow.

Luke 5:18-19 NIV
